## 1 Purpose of this document

This instruction provides a method for handling Certification IDs throughout the lifecycle of an evaluation and certification project and its optional re-evaluations. It also addresses the issue that TrustCB requires every certificate they issue to be uniquely identified while still maintaining easy reference to previously issued certificates related to the same product.

## 2 Certification ID

After acceptance of the NSCIB Application Form, TrustCB generates a unique certification/project ID (YYXXXXX-NN). This number is fully formatted as NSCIB-TT-YYXXXXX-NN-MAn, where:

- NSCIB is the scheme identifier,
- TT is the certification type (CC for product certifications, PP for Protection Profiles and SS for Site Certification). Used in the full version of the Certification ID.
- YY is a two-digit year (YY) reflecting acceptance of application,
- XXXXX is an increasing number for that year, generated and assigned by TrustCB
- NN is the certification iteration suffix.
- MA is the maintenance indicator for a Maintenance Addendum.
- n is a counter.

This number shall be used as the Certification/project ID in all documentation and correspondence related to the evaluation of the product.

If an application is received for recertification of a certificate, the same base Certification ID (NSCIB-TT-YYXXXXX) will be used, with the certification iteration suffix (-NN) increased by one to indicate an iteration of the certification.

If an application is received for maintenance of an existing certification, the maintenance indicator (-MA<sub>n</sub>) is appended to the NSCIB-TT-YYXXXXX-NN of the original certification. The -NN is unchanged from the original certification.

As per NSI\_12\_Project\_Communication, the Certification ID should be used in all certification related information exchange, including emails and naming of project documents. In case of re-certification and maintenance the suffix should also be included in the Certification ID.

## 3 Document numbering convention

The following describes the numbering convention to be used on documents (this is based on, but distinct to, the certification ID).
