GSMA eSA Pricelist v1.3 (2026)

Below are the standard prices for typical certification projects running with a fully licensed evaluator for GSMA eSA certifications against GSMA eSA scheme requirements under SGP.06 v1.0.

Note this excludes licensed and administration costs to GSMA and to the evaluation lab.

A-typical projects are estimated up-front on a case-by-case basis.

Re-certification – with Scope Change	2	€ 23.000

The above prices assume the meetings between the certifier and the evaluator (and optionally the Sponsor) will be held remotely. If the Sponsor wishes those **meetings to be held in-person** an **additional €2000 per meeting** will be added to the certification price.

Note 1: In case of a major scope change, it may be not possible to apply for a maintenance with major changes.

Typical costs of additional certification activities:

Late rescheduling of in-person meeting	1 in-person meeting	€ 3.850
Additional evaluation meeting (required if earlier evaluation meeting led to fail conclusion)	1 in-person meeting	€ 8.250
Additional extended ¹ evaluation meeting (required if earlier meeting led to fail conclusion, with serious issues in evaluation activities preformed indicating the project has gone outside of the optimized path)	1 in-person meeting	€ 11.000

All prices are excluding VAT and subject to the TrustCB general conditions.

¹ If an extra meeting is needed, the project has gone outside of the optimized path hence it will be an *extended* meeting.
